You will plan, deliver and lead in conjunction with a School Partnership Officer employed by MUF, on an exciting new programme designed to identify and support disengaged students, through a series of leadership, mentoring and sports programmes over the course of the next three years.

The Role

You will need to deliver the key objectives as outlined in schedule 1 of the Service Level Agreement between the partners which accompanies the Job Description and Person Specification. These can be further defined and negotiated depending on your experience and skill set. These objectives will be met through your work with young people.

Here are some examples of the objectives:

- You will work with Central Academy to identify and support students with the aim to increase attendance and reduce persistent absence through a series of leadership and mentoring programmes.
- You will work with the Central Academy transition team to further raise the profile of the Academy with its designated feeder Primary schools each term.
- You will provide structured skill specific sessions with a long-term vision to improve performance and signpost participants into activity and potentially on to clubs in the local community.
- You will provide additional activities and support as required, in liaison with the Central Academy, CUCST, MUF and Riverside (such as holiday provision and school trips).
